HCPR T-BALL Q & A

Q: Will I need to provide Birth Certificate or any other documentation the day of registration?

A: Generally a Birth Certificate will not be required, but may be requested if your child appears to be outside of the age guidelines.

Q: If my child will be 4 next month can they still register to play this season?

A: As long as your child will be <u>at least 4 by the start of the season May 1, (of current year)</u> <u>NOT have turned 7 by Sept. 1, (of current year</u> they are eligible to play T-ball this season.

Q: How much does it cost?

A: The cost is \$20, <u>check or money order only</u> made payable to "Sheriff & Treasurer of Harrison Co." <u>We can NOT accept cash or credit cards.</u>

Q: Where will games and practices be held?

A: Clinics (teaching players how to throw and other game basics) will be held at North View Elementary. Practice and Games will be held at Summit Park.

Q: How long do games and practices generally last?

A: Practice and Games are usually around 45 min to an hour in length.

Q: Will I know what team my child will be on the day I register?

A: No, Teams will be selected once registration is completed and announced at clinics.

Q: Can I volunteer to Coach or assist on the day of registration?

A: Absolutely, you will need to fill out a background check form.

Q: Do you have to be a resident of Clarksburg to register for HCPR T-ball? **A:** No, sign ups are open to any resident in Harrison County within the stipulated age group.

Q: Is this program for boys only?

A: No, the program is open to both boys and girls.

Q: Do I need to bring my child to registration?

A: Parent or legal guardian MUST be present to register child. Children need not be present.

Q: What dates and times will practice and games be held?

A: There will be 2 practices/games per week weather permitting. Actual dates and times of upcoming practice and games will not be available until registration is completed.

Registration dates will be posted each season as soon as they are determined.

Registration dates will be held at Harrison County Parks and Recreation Complex 43 Recreation Drive (Rt 19 South across from Sunny Croft Golf Course)
