

HARRISON COUNTY PARKS & RECREATION ADVISORY BOARD OPERATION

The Advisory Board operates under West Virginia Code, Article Eleven, Chapter Seven, and was established by the Harrison County Commission in 1971. The eleven volunteer members are appointed by the County Commission in accordance with the West Virginia Code.

Regular meetings are held the third Tuesday of each month with the exception of the months of August and December, at 8:00 a.m. The annual meeting for the purpose of election officers is held in September. The meetings are open to the public.

The purpose of the Board is to establish, improve, develop, administrate, operate and maintain a public parks and recreation system and public recreational facilities for Harrison County. The Advisory Board determines and establishes policy for implementation of this purpose.

The Harrison County Commission annually allocates funds to the Harrison County Parks and Recreation Department through the Vital Services Levy. These funds are utilized for office and park operations, maintenance and development, administrative staff and program services.
