

HCPR FALL YOUTH BASKETBALL Q & A

Q: Will I need to provide Birth Certificate or any other documentation the day of registration?

A: **No**, the only thing you will need is a check or money order (**NO CASH**) for \$20 payable to Sheriff & Treasurer of Harrison Co.
***Payment is due at the time of registration**

Q: Where will games and practices be held?

A: North View Elementary, and YMCA

Q: How long do games and practices generally last?

A: Practice and Games are usually around 45 min to an hour in length.

Q: Will I know what team my child will be on the day I register?

A: **No**, Teams will be selected once registration is completed and announced at clinics.

Q: Can I volunteer to Coach or assist on the day of registration?

A: Absolutely

***You must provide a copy of your WV DL or ID and submit a background check form.**

Q: If my child will be 5 next month can they still register to play this season?

A: As long as your child will be at least 5 by Sept 1
NOT have turned 9 by Dec. 1, they are eligible to play Youth Basketball this season.

Q: Do you have to be a resident of Clarksburg to register for HCPR Youth Basketball?

A: **NO**, sign ups are open to any resident in Harrison County within the stipulated age group.

Q: Is this program for boys only?

A: **NO**, the program is open to both boys and girls.

Q: Do I need to bring my child to registration?

A: Parent or legal guardian **MUST** be present to register child. Children need not be present.

Q: What dates and times will practice and games be held?

A: There will be 2 practices/games per week and rotating Saturdays, weather permitting. Actual dates and times of upcoming practice and games will not be available until registration is completed.
